



Child Care Provider Bulk Food Purchasing Program

Buying in larger quantities usually leads to a lower cost per unit! That is why Steuben Child Care Project has created this new program for providers. We have partnered with Reinhart Food Service in trying to bring that savings to the child care provider. This is offered to all child care programs that participate in CACFP or are an ICAN Member.

Each Provider is sent an order sheet with their CACFP reimbursement check. The provider reviews the order sheet, selects the items they would like to purchase, notes an authorized pick-up designee, and makes a copy and return the original sheet **with payment by the deadline listed on the order form** (this can be included with any Subsidy or CACFP claims as long as it is placed in a separate envelope with Attention Bulk Food Program written on the front.) Payment is made by cash, check or credit card. The provider, or authorized pick up person, comes to the ICAN site to pick up the order items **on the day and time listed** on the order sheet.

The mission of this program is to assist providers meet the challenge of bringing down the cost of food for their program. If the provider wants to split the cost of the items with **another provider**, that is their responsibility. One provider must be in charge of the order and list a pick-up designee on the form.
